

## **9.6 IPRs produced: Total number of IPR including patent, copyright, trademark granted in the last 3 years**

### **Introduction**

Thunchath Ezhuthachan Malayalam University was established by the Government of Kerala in 2012 by an act in Kerala legislative assembly. Creating an ecosystem for the production, dissemination, and preservation of knowledge systems that address local, regional, and global concerns has been one of the core founding principles of our university. Therefore, in line with the vision and commitment of the university, the academic programmes, as well as governance structures, wholeheartedly strive for mapping and preserving regional and geographic-centric knowledge systems possessed by various knowledge communities like Adivasis, fisherfolk, traditional craftsmen of different sorts, etc. scattered across Kerala. Using the mother tongue (Malayalam) as the medium of instruction for postgraduate courses and research programmes, the university aims at the democratization of knowledge by promoting students from these traditional knowledge communities and other sections of the population who wish to pursue their higher studies in the native language.

Thunchath Ezhuthachan Malayalam University has IPR policy which covers all rights arising from intellectual property devised, created, or made and established by the staff in the course of their employment at the university, irrespective of the eligibility of these rights for registration. The IP arising from academic research on any type of knowledge article includes patents, designs, trademarks, service marks, copyright, know-how, and undisclosed information.

### **Details of Copyrights Malayalam University Secured**

Thunchath Ezhuthachan Malayalam University is having a well-developed publication department. The university secures the copy rights of the published books and journals. Since its inception 2016 it published 69 academic books. Moreover, it publishes 6 research journals namely Malayala Bhashasastram Gaveshana Journal, Malayalasaahithya gaveshana Journal, Sociology Gaveshana Journal, Charithrapadana School Gaveshana Journal, Thunchathezuthachan Geveshanapathrika, and Paithrikavimarsham Journal.
